### Program Options (additional fees apply)

Before & After Care

Swim Instruction - daily swimming lessons at Cornerstone \$100 per session

Academic Enrichment - two 50-minute individual periods per week \$180 per session

**Preschool Program:** Offered for children ages 3 and 4 by the beginning of Session 1, parents can choose between a half-day option from 9:00 - 1:00, which includes a hot lunch, and a full day option from 9:00 - 4:00. The program is designed for preschoolers to play, learn and socialize with their friends, both old and new. Each day you'll find our campers laughing, playing and learning as they explore new things and enjoy their summer. At Camp Create-a-Summer, your preschool child will enjoy a summer filled with engaging activities including: nature walks, arts & crafts, sports, music & specialty days.

Campers are grouped according to age and the program will be staffed by seasoned preschool teachers. Children will enjoy Schechter's fully equipped preschool classrooms with a portion of each day spent outside on the facility's two playgrounds, sports fields and sprinkler park. Campers will also have opportunities to work with the camp's music, arts & crafts and sports specialists.

The **Upper Camp** is open to children entering kindergarten through 8th grade. Campers will spend each two-week session "creating their summer" by choosing up to 4 activities per session and focusing on building skills in these particular areas. Campers can select to explore a variety of new activities or focus on developing and refining skills in particular areas of interest. Programming is differentiated to suit the novice and more experienced camper. Opportunities for private music lessons and sports training are available. Work with professional coaches, artists and musicians, create a portfolio or complete a project. Choose from a remarkable range of activities from golf to robotics, animation to rock band. Make the summer what you want it to be. It's your choice.
